FOR UNITED STATES CITIZEN STUDENTS OF ASIAN OR ASIAN AMERICAN HERITAGE**

Scholarship Eligibility:

To be considered for the above scholarships, all applicants must:

1. Be enrolled at the UA as a **full-time undergraduate or graduate student** in a degree or certificate program, taking a minimum of 12 units per semester for undergraduates, 9 units for graduate students;
2. Be a U.S. citizen of Asian, Asian American or Pacific Islander descent;
3. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 for undergraduate students, or 3.25 for graduate students;
4. Show unmet financial need as reported on your 2004-05 Financial Aid Award Letter received from the UA Office of Student Financial Aid.

Scholarship Award: The scholarship is a one-time award. The scholarship award amounts will vary based on individual need as described in the autobiographical essay (see below). Additional documentation may be required prior to award.

Application Process:

All applicants must submit the following:

- Scholarship Application Form (page 2 of this announcement);
- One current letter of recommendation from a University of Arizona faculty member or major advisor;
- A short autobiographical essay to express your thoughts on what role or impact your ethnicity as an Asian or Asian American may have in your personal development;
- An autobiographical essay which highlights your academic achievements, your career goals, and which addresses, in detail, your financial need;
- Official transcript from the University of Arizona or, if you are a first semester Freshman, from high school;
- Copy of your 2004-05 UA Financial Aid Award Letter.

Application Deadline:

All applications **must be received by Friday, October 29, 2004**. No partial or late applications will be accepted. Review of applications will be done only if all required documents are completed and submitted by the deadline date. Submit all required documents to:
